You must submit a new application if you intend to expand your approved tissue, hematopoietic progenitor cell, and/or nontransplant anatomic banking services or activities beyond those listed on this certificate. Your license is specific to this location; you must notify the Department of any changes in address.

To remain in compliance with New York State regulations, you must also:

- Report any changes in tissue bank director, hematopoietic progenitor cell bank director, medical director, nontransplant anatomic bank director, person responsible for Article 43-B, and/or tissue bank compliance officer;
- Report any change in ownership of five percent or more;
- Report any accidents in retrieval, testing, processing, storage or distribution of tissue that may affect the safety of any product within seven calendar days of discovery.
